



WHAT HAPPENS IF IT SNOWS OR THE ROADS ARE ICY?

If we have snow during the night or the roads are icy, or other emergency closures.

1. Our Transportation Manager Randy Rooney will drive our bus routes at 5:00 a.m.
2. Mr. Bingham and Mr. Rooney will make the decision if school will be open.
3. If we decide to close school a ROBO call will go out to the parents' primary phone number and to all staff that school is closed. You can also check the following:
 - A. KOMO TV 4 – Updated by Mr. Bingham
 - B. KING TV 5 – Updated by Mr. Bingham
 - C. KIRO TV 7 - Updated by Mr. Bingham

 - F. Crescent Website – crescentschooldistrict.org – updated by Nora Williams
4. If we will have a 2 hour late start a ROBO call will go out to the parents' primary phone number and to all staff that school will open 2 hours later than normal.
 - A. You can check all above sources for a late start.
 - B. Buses will run 2 hours behind the normal pick up times.
5. Once students have arrived at school we will keep them here until the normal release time. Unless:
 - A. If the weather forecast changes drastically and reports are that we will receive several feet of snow before the end of school, if we decide it would be safer to send the students home early, we will:
 - a. Send out a ROBO call stating that we will be sending the students home early and why.
 - b. Ask that the parent call us back as to whether to send their student home on the bus, or hold the student at school for the parent or designated person to pick them up at the school. If we hold them at school, after the buses depart we will combine the students into one area of pick up. The parent or designated person would come to the office to sign out the students and those students will meet them at the office. If you can call ahead when headed to pick them up we can have them in the office and ready to go.
6. Some bus routes can be placed on a snow route where the buses will not be able to drive up certain roads. The snow route notification is attached to the back of this letter.
